Hurricane / Tropical Storm Watch - Final Preparations

- All Shutters up
- Cisterns Fill
- Supplies someplace secure
- Top Up: Car, gas, fuel, phone credit

Hurricane / Tropical Storm Warning - Life Safety

- Prepare your shelter
- Charge up: phones, batteries, entertainment for the kids, power tools, cistern pump batteries

During the Storm:

Stay safe. Remember the winds may appear to stop completely if the eye passes directly over you. This does not mean it is safe to venture out. Strong gusts are still possible, and the second part of the eye wall might pass over you at any moment.

After the Storm:

Do you have your immediate needs met? (Shelter, water, food.) Does anyone need medical attention? Are your neighbors OK? Tune in to the radio to check for updates. Stay off the roads unless absolutely necessary.
